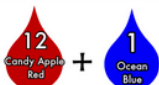


Simi Color Splash

Color Mixing Guide

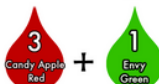
Airbrushing & Hand Painting

Black:



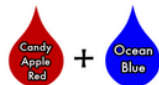
TIPS:
Mix paints in a small cup before use, this allows for the most even color distribution.

Brown:



Use Base White or Dilution Solution to lighten any color. Base White will create opacity, Dilution Solution will keep the paints transparent

Purple:



To airbrush Base White, thin with 1 part Dilution Solution to 1 part Base White before adding to airbrush cup

To create pink & purple, start with a base of Dilution Solution alone for transparent colors OR 1 part Base White + 1 part Dilution Solution for solid colors. Stir in toothpick dips of color, adding Candy Apple Red for pink. To turn this purple, add a **small** toothpick dip of Ocean Blue.



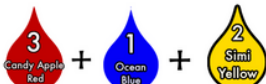
Pink:



All amounts are measured in drops

Coloring Isomalt

Black:



TIPS:

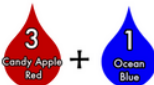
Use caution, isomalt is extremely hot. Wear gloves to protect your hands from the heat.

Brown:



Mix into pre-heated isomalt one drop at a time. For best results, bring isomalt back to a boil after coloring and allow to settle at room temperature to boil out any air mixed in from stirring. Do not mix Dilution Solution into isomalt.

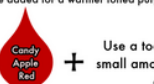
Purple*:



*This creates a very deep purple. For lighter tones, pre-mix color in a small cup then use a toothpick to dip and stir in small amounts of color. Toothpick dips of red may be added for a warmer toned purple.

If a pale color is desired, unscrew the cap and use a toothpick to dip into the color and then stir that into the isomalt.

Pink:



Use a toothpick to add small amounts of color at a time

All amounts are measured in drops, mixed into a base of 6oz Clear Simi Isomalt
