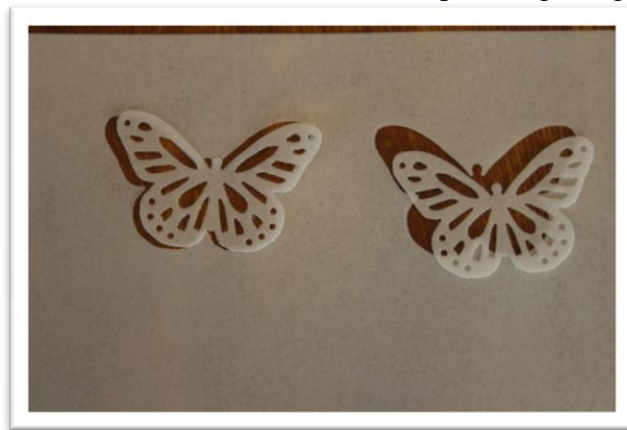


Wafer Paper Butterfly Dome

Using a butterfly template or the Sweet Accents™ machine and food safe butterfly dies, cut 30 butterflies out of Icing Images® Premium Wafer Paper. You can choose any or several of the colored and flavored sheets of Wafer Paper Icing Images has.



Starting in the center, attach each butterfly to the next by the wing tips with a tiny amount of water. Make sure the smooth side of the paper is facing up.



Place the circle of butterflies on top of a large 5" plastic half ball (or Styrofoam).



Waive a steamer closely over the wafer paper and the paper will gently fall over and form to the ball.

Be careful not to linger and apply too much steam, it will dissolve the wafer paper.

As the paper forms to the half ball, any excess butterflies can be cut out so a smooth dome is achieved. Butterflies can be added and attached (with water) to fill any gaps as well.



Let dry and carefully remove.
